## **AoGI Candidate Development and Requirements**

Our candidates must demonstrate the qualifications for elder and deacons as laid out in 1 Timothy 3 and Titus 1. Below are the highlights of our development process which takes place through the local church. Typically this will take a candidate 2-3 years to complete.

## Serving in the Local Church

- Membership and consistent active ministry in the local church for 2 years
- Demonstrate tithing
- Fundamentals of Biblical Counseling Training
- Complete the NANC Biblical counseling exam
- Participate as a counselor
- Participate as small group leader

**Completing our Joshua's Men or Women of the Word Program**, a 2 year program consisting of reading and meeting monthly as a group to discuss

- 1<sup>st</sup> year <u>Systematic Theology</u> by Wayne Grudem
- 2<sup>nd</sup> year One book a month (on various spiritual development and leadership topics)
